FONDAZIONE PRINTO PRIVACY POLICY

Fondazione PAEDIATRIC RHEUMATOLOGY INTERNATIONAL TRIALS

ORGANISATION ETS (“we,” “our,” or “us”) is a non-profit organization dedicated to advancing clinical research, promoting collaboration among healthcare professionals, and supporting evidence-based medical innovation.

We respect and protect your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, disclose, and safeguard your personal data when you interact with us, apply for or maintain membership, or participate in our research and educational activities.

We process personal data in compliance with the **EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)**, and any other applicable data protection laws.

a) Data Controller

Fondazione PRINTO ETS, an organization incorporated under the laws of Italy (Fiscal Code 96080870189, VAT number IT 02809770189) whose registered office is in Pavia, Via Sant’Ennodio 1/A, (27100) (hereinafter “Fondazione **PRINTO**”), is the organization which, as Data Controller, collects and processes your personal data in accordance with EU Regulation 2016/679 *General Data Protection Regulation* (the “**GDPR**”) and provides you with the following information.

b) Data Protection Officer

c) Purposes and legal basis of the processing

If you give your consent, the data you provide us will be used by Fondazione PRINTO to subscribe you to our Newsletter, update you on our initiatives and activities, assess membership applications; maintain accurate member records, and manage renewals; facilitate participation in clinical research projects including liaisons with pharmaceutical companies, working groups, or scientific committees (subject to consent where required).

Only the data requested as “_mandatory_” is required for subscribing to the Newsletter. The failure to fill in data indicated as “_optional_” does not have any consequence.

If consent for subscription to the newsletter is not given, the data will be used exclusively to contact you regarding any possible opportunities.

The legal basis for the processing of your data will be your consent. **Your consent can be withdrawn at any time.**

d) Storage period

Your data will be processed for the entire duration of your subscription to the Newsletter or until consent is withdrawn.

e) Processing methods and recipients

Your data will mostly be processed electronically and will not be disclosed. Your data may only be communicated to persons authorized to the processing within Fondazione PRINTO, and may come to knowledge to the following third parties:

- Authorized staff and governing bodies of Fondazione PRINTO, solely for the performance of their duties and within the limits of their authorization;
- External service providers (data processors) who support Fondazione PRINTO in its activities (e.g. IT and hosting providers, membership management software, communication platforms, accounting or administrative services, event organisation services). These entities process data exclusively on behalf of and under the instructions of the Foundation, in accordance with written Data Processing Agreements compliant with Article 28 GDPR;
- External service providers entrusted with the management of the website and related electronic archives;
- Public authorities or other entities, where required by law or upon a legitimate and lawful request.

Where necessary, Fondazione PRINTO could designate the processing recipients as Data Processor for the local data pursuant to art. 28 of the GDPR. A list of all the Data Processors designated by Fondazione PRINTO can be provided upon request.

f) Transmission of data outside the European Union

Where we transfer your personal data outside the European Union, we will ensure that it is protected and transferred in a manner consistent with the GDPR. In particular, for the transfer of personal data to third countries which are not considered ensuring an adequate level of protection, we will enter into the standard contractual clauses approved by the European Commission Implementing Decision of 4 June 2021 and any subsequent amendment or re-edition.

g) Data subject's rights

By notice to be sent to the e-mail address info@fondazione-printo.it, you may at any time exercise the rights provided for by articles 15 to 22 of the Regulation, such as:

- *obtaining confirmation whether personal data concerning you is being processed*

- *obtaining access to your personal data and to the information set out in Article 15 of the Regulation;*
- *obtaining the rectification of the inaccurate personal data that concern you without undue delay or the supplementing of incomplete personal data;*
- *obtaining the erasure of the personal data that concern you without undue delay;*
- *obtaining the restriction of processing the personal data that concern you;*
- *being informed of any rectifications or erasures or restrictions of processing in relation to the personal data that concern you;*
- *receiving in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format the personal data that concern you;*
- *objecting at any time, on grounds associated with your specific situation, to the processing of the personal data that concern you.*

h) Complaint to the Data Protection Authority

Should you consider the processing of your data infringes the Regulation, you may in any event lodge a complaint with the Italian Data Protection Authority (www.garanteprivacy.it), or, if different, to the Data Protection Authority of the Member State of your habitual residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement.
